

UUCWI Music Subcommittee Role Description

Approved by BOT May 9, 2005

Purpose: To provide inspirational music to enhance UUCWI worship experiences and church events. Music is an important part of the UUCWI ministry.

Nature: This is a standing committee that operates as a subcommittee of the Worship committee. Its members are appointed by the Worship Committee. Its budget is identified separately to provide visibility.

Key Responsibilities:

To advise and assist the Worship Committee and its Chair in:

- Ensuring that a high quality music program for UUCWI is planned and implemented.
- Seeking input of congregation members, and their feedback on the effectiveness of the music program
- Preparing the Music budget annually with input from the Music Director and Choir Director. Recommending compensation rates for paid positions.
- Monitoring music expenditures.
- Ensuring that the positions of Music Director and Choir Director are staffed and that accompanists and musicians are engaged.
- Coordinating with the Music director and Choir director in planning schedules, budget expenditures and other matters as delegated by the Worship Committee or its chair.
- Ensuring that contributions of staff, choir, and paid and volunteer musicians are recognized.
- Encouraging and enabling training for staff and volunteers.
