UUCWI Committees

Adult Programs: schedule and organize adult programs for congregants

Board of Trustees: provide church leadership, establish and oversee the budget, recruit and confirm committee chairs and other key volunteer positions, oversee interaction with UUA and PNWD

Building Committee: oversee the purchase, building, and maintenance of church physical property

Canvass Committee: oversee the annual pledge drive for operating funds

Capital Campaign Committee: oversee the development of capital funds to support our own building and improvements

Caring Connections Committee: provide support, comfort, and assistance to church members in need

Children's Religious Education Committee: oversee and support the CRE program, recruit, select and train a CRE Coordinator when needed, recruit teachers as needed

Communication: oversee publicity and internal communications for the congregation

Membership Committee: respond to church visitors and callers, guide visitors through the membership process when appropriate, maintain current membership information with the Church Coordinator, coordinate volunteer activity within the church

Committee on Ministry: coordinate and oversee ministerial functions with the minister

Music Committee: oversee and schedule musicians, accompanists, the choir and director, and other music functions during Worship Services and at other church events

Nominating Committee: recruit church members to run for election to the Board of Trustees

Social Action Committee: select social action goals for the church (local, national and international), develop and implement activities to further these selected goals

Worship Committee: schedule speakers, readers, facilitators and refreshments for Worship Services, coordinate with speakers to select songs and readings, provide information for the Order of Service to the Church Coordinator, schedule room set-up and clean-up
